

On October 21st, four UHS seniors participated in the Twenty-First Annual Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) Mathematics Meet. They were Ryan Normandin, Rachel Drywa, Derek Belanger and Patrick Rice. The meet took place in two parts.

The first is the individual competition where students answer mathematic questions that are beyond the normal high school level. Students are awarded scholarships based on the number of questions they answer correctly. WPI awards a \$1000 scholarship to the top scorer of each four person team. Our \$1000 award winner this year was Ryan Normandin who answered six of eleven questions correctly.

The second part is a team competition where each school answers questions together. This year's honorary team captain was math teacher – Dave Balunas. As a team, we had the best finish for Uxbridge in eight years; we finished in the top 39 out of 87 schools.

These four students have completed Advanced Placement Calculus as juniors and are taking Honors Calculus II/Discrete Mathematics as seniors.
