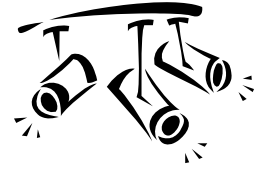

Subject/Course/Classroom Activities

Monthly Faculty Meeting: The monthly meeting for Whitin School faculty was held on Monday, April 6. The faculty meeting agenda included attention to the following topics: curriculum planning projects, MCAS testing, and report card timeline, and an update on the budget. A copy of the complete faculty meeting agenda is attached.

District Wide Choral Concert: On Wednesday evening, April 15, 2009, the Whitin Middle School Chorus and the Uxbridge High School Chorus joined together in song to present “A Choral Extravaganza!” The Whitin Middle School, under the direction of Mrs. Jeanne Rapoza and Mr. Robert Hammerton, performed first. The high school choir, under the direction of Mr. Nick LaPete, concluded the concert. There were also featured performances by Shane Robinson and Jacqueline Shaw. Shane, who was selected to participate in the Massachusetts Central District Chorus, performed his audition piece, Caro Mio Ben. Jacqueline who was a CMass Hero finalist played the piano and sang Falling Slowly for her selection. The students were excited to perform together and see former classmates and the progress they have made singing together over the years. Students in both choirs have been rehearsing after school since December to prepare for this concert.

Grade 5 Zoo Mobile: The fifth grade class invited the Zoo Mobile to present on April 16th - special thanks to the sponsorship of the PTO. The Zoo Mobile is the Southwick’s Zoo traveling exhibit. The students were able to learn about the habitats, adaptations, and instincts of various rare mammals, amphibians, and reptiles. The class participated in the event by viewing and touching the animals, along with a question and answer segment at the end. The event was sure a walk on the wild side!

Spring 2009 MCAS: Whitin Middle School students participated in the first of two rounds of spring MCAS testing. Testing occurred from March, 30, 2009 – April 13, 2009. The focus areas for this session were Reading Comprehension and English Language Arts Composition. The second MCAS session will occur in May.

Whitin Drama Club: 60 students from grades 5,6,7,8 are performing a musical titled Lagooned. Two performances are scheduled to be held on Friday May 15, 2009 at 3:00 and 7:00 P.M. The tickets cost \$5.00 each. In this maritime musical comedy, a sequel to our production Don't Rock the Boat two years ago, a group of crazy castaways are shipwrecked in the middle of the South Pacific. But this isn't any old atoll! It belongs to fantasy tours that create shipwrecks for wealthy clients, complete with jungle drums and a tribe of restless natives! 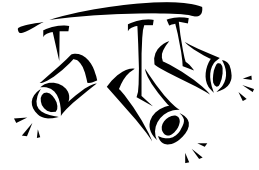

Grade 8 Class Trip – Preliminary Information

This year's Grade 8 Class Trip to Six Flags New England is scheduled for Friday, June 5th. For many people, there is one simple reason to go to an amusement park: the rides. Whitin School students will find an even better reason to go: math and science. Students will spend Friday, June 5th at Six Flags where volunteer instructors will help them learn about physics and math. To prepare for our trip, students will be expected to complete a course of study in science and math classes that involves learning formulas and strategies for calculating specific events. Upon completing these lessons successfully, the reward will be a visit to Science and Math Day at Six Flags. Students will be given activity packets, and park instructors will provide lessons and experiments geared especially for 8th graders. Students will be expected to record observations, answer questions, and investigate different physical events throughout the day. This cross-curricular activity should prove to be a positive learning experience for all of us.

Please note: Grade 8 students will be required to complete all trip related assignments in order to participate on June 5th. Any student suspended from school may be excluded from the trip.

Grade 8 Dinner Dance

The annual Grade 8 Dinner Dance is scheduled to be held on Monday evening, June 15th at Arrowhead Acres, 92 Aldrich St., Rt. 98 from 7:00-10:00P.M. This event represents the last opportunity for 8th graders to meet socially as a class. The following preliminary information is intended to help parents plan for this event.

The dinner dance is not a high school prom. Parents are asked to cooperate by keeping it simple. Gowns, extravagant dresses, and tuxedos are too formal. Flowers are not necessary. Limousines are not appropriate. The dinner dance is not planned as a couple's event.
